- We have 30 kids registered, We only anticipate maybe 4 - 5 more tickets. "Deadline" to buy tickets is May 15th.

- One more fundraiser coming up.
 - **Hazel Dell Parade of Bands – Saturday, May 19, 2018 – from 9:30 AM to 2 PM**
Volunteers are needed to carry banners in the parade announcing winners of each division. For this fun event, volunteers can range from age 12 through adult, so high school students and their families/friends can volunteer to help. The parade itself is 2.2 miles and the volunteers will be provided t-shirts to wear in the parade. A total of 16 - 20 volunteers are needed. **This fundraiser is anticipated to raise \$250**
 - **So far we have 6 seniors officially signed up, although we anticipate more. We will also ask other High school students if they would like to participate.**
 - Also needed are a few high school students to hold staging signs from 7:30am to 10:00am that day. Breakfast and t-shirts are provided for these volunteers as well as volunteer hours.
- We are making our final payment to Marshall Center for \$2746. (This does include \$500 returnable deposit which hopefully can be added for Grad night next year.) Need a few volunteers (maybe some HS Jr or others) parents for help to start setting up the dance area at the Marshall Center while we are at graduation with our kids. It won't be elaborate, and shouldn't take long, but would give us a big head start before volunteer parents could get to the venue. Kids will be eating at restaurant right after graduation.
- We have secured La Costa Mexican restaurant for Grad Night Meal for \$200 and in exchange, his logo will be advertised on Battle Ground Cinema in our thank you ad! BTW, our ad will run at BG Cinema June 1-30th. Our artwork is due on May 15th. Jodi Tripp is working on this project.
